

ESMT Berlin's MBA is an excellent investment in your future. Rated highly by the Financial Times for value for money, graduates typically recoup the tuition fee after 14 months. Tuition and fees for the full-time MBA are €49,500. Most students fund their studies with a mix of personal funds, loans, and scholarships. Unlimited scholarships are available based on early application, GMAT or GRE scores, and German language skills (non-native speakers only). These can be combined with one other merit-based scholarship – check out the list of scholarships available on our website.

ESMT works with multiple providers to make it easier for you to finance your degree. These include Prodigy Finance, Brain Capital, and Juno. Special funding options are available for nationals of other countries while US citizens may apply for Title IV student and GI Bill loans. More information is available on our website.




